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SCHEDULE OF DUE DATES

Students enrolled/enrolling at Music Academies of Adria, Castelfranco Veneto, Padova, Rovigo, Vicenza of schools for Linguistic Mediators of Padova, Vicenza (and Belluno site), CIELS (Padova and Milano sites) who wish to participate in the Accommodation and Scholarships competition must complete the online application, in the manner indicated in this Notice for applications, by 13:00 by 13:00 on the deadline day indicated in the following table.

The deadlines are peremptory and, therefore, it will not normally be possible to fill in or supplement the application already submitted after these deadlines.

The electronic system of ESU online services certifies the date and time of submission of the online application, providing a receipt and registration number.

N.B.

Please ensure that you submit your "DSU" (Single Substitute Declaration) and the documents necessary for calculating your ISEE "ordinario"/"parificato" to the "CAF" (Tax Assistance Centre) in good time, bearing in mind that at least 15 working days are necessary for issuing certificates by the CAF, who cannot be held responsible for any delay.

Foreign or Italian students residing abroad must request their "ISEE Parificato universitario" from the CAF with which we have special arrangements - CIA, located in Via Longhin, 25, Padua). It is advisable to complete the application for your ISEE/ISPE and Parificato **as soon as possible in order to receive your ISEE in time for the first assignment.**

The procedure for applications and certificate issue is only accessible on-line.

For details about the procedure, please refer to annex 4, an integral and essential part of this Notice).

Students submitting the ISEE Parificato must upload it in the "Carica Documenti/Upload Documents" section of the Sportello Studente/Student Help Desk.

Only as an exception, international students enrolled on the first year of a course can supplement their application for participation in the Competition for the assignment of accommodation by submitting their "ISEE parificato universitario" by 30/11/2022. These applications will be subsequently evaluated according to the criteria already established for first year students and the allocation of accommodation will take place on the basis of any remaining availability of accommodation.

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1 - INFORMATION ON THE HOUSING SERVICE AND SCHOLARSHIP

The housing service and scholarships are included among the benefits for the right to university study. They are awarded by competition to students who possess the merit and financial requirements provided for by the law

1.1 – Who can apply

Students enrolled/enrolling for A.Y. 2022/2023, graduating students and students transferring from an institution not belonging to ESU can participate in the competition for accommodation and scholarships.

The benefits referred to in the competition can be granted only for the achievement, for the first time, of the qualification relating to each level of study regardless of the university where it was obtained (Italian or foreign).

Students can participate in the competition for the allocation of ESU accommodation for the academic year 2022/2023 if they are in the categories "Off Site" and "Commuter".

Students can participate in the competition for the allocation of scholarship for the academic year 2022/2023 if they are in the categories "Off Site", "Commuter" and "In Site".

<p>Off Site Student</p>	<p>Resides in municipalities/locations more than 80 km from the venue of the course attended and/or has travel times (by public transport) greater than 80 minutes and who, for this reason, take accommodation near that site, in public residential structures or other accommodation run by private individuals or entities, for consideration, with a regular contract, for a period of not less than 10 months. Students residing in a municipality or location more than 80 km or more than 80 minutes away from the site of the course and who do not take accommodation for consideration or for a period of less than 10 months are considered Commuters.</p> <p>International mobility students; maintain their off-site status by documenting that they are staying paid accommodation even during the mobility period, for a period, including that in Italy, of not less than ten months.</p> <p>Foreign students with residence permit for study purposes, for the purposes of access to the benefits, are deemed Off-Site students, regardless of the location of their residence in Italy (and in any case, must stay in accommodation for consideration with a regular contract at the site of the course of study for a period equal to the duration of the course itself).</p> <p><u>This is not the case</u> if the student's family unit resides in Italy, according to the requirements set out in art. 4, paragraph 8, letter c) of the DPCM of 9.4.2001</p> <p>Off-site students participating in the SCHOLARSHIPS competition, who will be residing in NON-ESU accommodation, must upload by 10/10/2022, in the Upload Documents/Carica Documenti area of the portal https://myesupd.dirittoallostudio.it, a copy of the lease and its registration with the revenue agency, Agenzia delle Entrate.</p>
<p>Commuter Student</p>	<p>Resides in Municipalities/Locations between 40 and 80 km from the venue of the course attended and/or has travel times (by public transport) between 40 and 80 minutes.</p>



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On Site Student	Resides in Municipalities/Locations less than 40 Km from the venue of the course attended and/or has travel times (by public transport) less than 40 minutes;
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For the definition of the status of Off-Site, Commuter and In Site, the student must strictly comply with the **Table of geographical distances** published by the University (<https://www.unipd.it/borse-studio-alloggi>).

As tables are not currently available for the **Adria site**, students must self-certify the conditions set out above, taking into account that travel times must be calculated using those officially declared by public transport companies for links between the Municipality of residence and the Municipality where the course is held.

ESU carries out checks on the actual condition of the student and if the non-truthfulness of what has been declared is proven, ESU will immediately revoke the benefits provided, will apply legal sanctions and will require payment of the assessment fee.

Regarding the accommodation competition:

- Students with **motor or visual disabilities** can participate regardless of their status;
- The benefit is granted primarily to **Off-Site** students;
- Upon entering the residence, students must already be **enrolled or enrolling** for the A.Y. 2022/23

ENROLLING STUDENTS

Students enrolled/enrolling for A.Y. 2022/2023 (and who have paid DSU Regional Tax of EUR 176.00) can participate in the competition for accommodation and scholarships:

- on courses of the upper period of the Music Academies of Adria, Castelfranco Veneto, Padua, Rovigo and Vicenza for a number of years equal to the legal duration of the course of study, with reference to the year of first enrolment;
- on the first level ordinance/experimental courses activated in accordance with DM 8.10.2003 prot n ° 629/AFAM/2003, at the Conservatoires for seven semesters (seven years for those enrolled on part-time study), with reference to the year of first enrolment; the housing service is granted for an additional semester;
- on the second level ordinance/experimental courses activated in accordance with DM 8.10.2003 prot n ° 1/AFAM/2004, at the Conservatoires for five semesters (five years for those enrolled on part-time study), with reference to the year of first enrolment; the housing service is granted for an additional semester;
- on the three-year degree courses at the Schools for Linguistic Mediators of Padua, Vicenza (and Belluno site), CIELS of Padua and Milan, Rome, activated pursuant to Ministerial Decree No. 509/99 - D.M 12/03/2010- DD Department for Higher Education and Research Prot 1966/2016 and 1059/2018) for a period of seven semesters starting from the year of first enrolment; the housing service is granted for an additional semester;
- on the master's degree (laurea magistrale) courses of the School for Linguistic Mediators CIELS based in Padua, activated pursuant to Ministerial Decree No. 243/2020, for a period of five semesters starting from the year of first enrolment; the housing service is granted for an additional semester

GRADUATING STUDENTS

Students who are graduating from a three-year (Triennio)/higher (Corso Superiore) course within the last graduation session of the AY. 2021/2022 and who enrol on the first year of two-year course in the AY 2022/2023, must complete the online application as first year students of two-year course, specifying the expected date of passing the three-year (Triennio)/higher (Corso Superiore) course.



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The application for the scholarship will remain frozen in a "state of suspension" until the qualification is obtained and enrolment for the two-year period is completed. For the suspension to be terminated, students must notify attainment of degree by initiating a "Ticket" via <https://myesupd.dirittoallostudio.it> > Sportello studente/Student Help desk> Concorso Borsa di Studi/Scholarship Competition (Non-UNIPD students).

Applications for accommodation are not subject to suspension.

The Higher Course Diploma (old system) together with the possession of an upper secondary school diploma is equivalent to the second level Academic Diploma (Biennio-Laurea Magistrale).

An old system university degree diploma is equivalent to a specialisation course (Laurea Magistrale)

TRANSFERRING STUDENTS

Students **transferring from another institution not belonging to ESU Padova**, to continue a degree course at the same level, can participate in the housing competition "with reserve" and obtain the assignment of accommodation from remaining availability once the benefit has been assigned to eligible Off-Site and Commuter students.

Their position will be "frozen" and the attribution of the fee will be determined on the basis of the data declared by the student and merit status defined by the University.

Applicants can notify their enrolment by initiating a "Ticket" from the portal <https://myesupd.dirittoallostudio.it> > Sportello student/ Student Help Desk > Concorso Borsa di Studio/Scholarship Competition (Non-UNIPD Students).

WITHDRAWAL FROM STUDIES

In the case of **withdrawal from studies** enrolment relating to a concluded career is not counted as long as the student, during the previous career, did not receive a scholarship or, if received, renounced it and returned the benefit by the time of submitting the application referred to in this competition.

Withdrawal from studies, which may have occurred during a three-year degree course (Laurea Triennale), does not affect the career of a two-year specialisation course (Laurea Magistrale).

Any credits acquired in the career subject to withdrawal cannot be computed for merit for the purpose of benefits in the new course of study.

1.2 - INCOMPATIBILITY AND EXCLUSIONS

INCOMPATIBILITY

A regional scholarship cannot be combined, for the same academic year, with other scholarships for purposes similar to maintenance, assigned for any reason.

Students enrolled at both the Conservatoire and at an Italian university at the same time (regardless of the degree course followed) must notify their dual enrolment by the deadline of 30 September 2022. In the event that the aforementioned students are included in the rankings of scholarship recipients of both ESU and the university attended, they **must opt - by the date of publication of the provisional rankings** - for one or the other benefit and notify this by initiating a "Ticket" via the portal <https://myesupd.dirittoallostudio.it> > Sportello studente/Student Help Desk> Concorso Borsa di Studio/Scholarship competition (non-UNIPD students).

EXCLUSIONS

Students are excluded from the allocation of accommodation and from the award of the scholarship as follows:

- students who do not fill in and do not confirm their online application within the deadlines;



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- students who have not paid the Regional Tax for DSU (Diritto allo Studio Universitario) (**Euros 176,00**) by the indicated deadline (date of enrolment with the institution or deadline for compiling online applications);
- students for whom records show no "DSU" (Single Substitute Declaration) - ISEE Certificate - ISEE Parificato universitario Year 2021 c/o INPS or CAF with which we have special arrangements CIA (located in Via Longhin 25, Padua) by the deadlines set out in the Notice;
- students who enrol for the second time on the same course level;
- students who have already obtained a diploma of a level equal to that for which they are applying for benefits;
- students who have already obtained a degree of a level equal to that for which they are applying for benefits;
- students who have already obtained a degree from a School for Linguistic Mediators or other University Institution;
- students who, in previous academic years, have undergone a revocation measure for their accommodation or for whom there is a pending revocation measure;
- students assigned ESA accommodation for the A.Y. 2021/2022, and who are not up to date with their payment of fees or who are in debt to the ESU in previous academic years;
- students who have withdrawn from their studies in previous academic years having benefited from accommodation at a reduced rate in the course year when withdrawal took place (**exclusively for the accommodation competition**);
- students who have incurred the penalties provided for by law following checks carried out on their self-certification.

1.3 - Who is the recipient of the benefit

To submit a regular application, students must be up to date with their payment of **Regional Fees for the Right to University Study (Euro 176.00)** using the online MyPay procedure (link <https://www.esu.pd.it/it/Pagine/pagamenti-elettronici.aspx>).

To access "eligible" rate accommodation and to be eligible for the Scholarship, the requirements are as follows:

Enrolled first years	FINANCIAL REQUIREMENTS ONLY (from ISEE/ISEE Parificato certification)
Enrolled subsequent years	MERIT (as of 10.08.2022) AND FINANCIAL (from ISEE/ISEE Parificato Certification)

1.3.1 – Financial requirements

The maximum income indicators established for the 2022/2023 academic year for participation in the Competition are:

Indicator of Equivalent Economic Situation ISEE (for DSU subsidies)	24,335.11 Euros
Indicator of Equivalent Asset Situation ISPE (ISP/equivalence scale)	37,031.71 Euros



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N.B.: the values of BOTH indicators must be observed

Considering that 15/20 days are necessary for issuing ISEE certification, a Single Substitute Declaration (DSU) should be submitted for ISEE calculation to Tax Assistance Centres (CAF), allowing sufficient time in order to meet the deadline for the application.

DSU/ISEE Certification data entered in the Form by the student will be checked with INPS, for the purpose of validation.

For details regarding the ISEE, please refer to annex 3, an integral and essential part of this Notice.

Foreign or Italian students residing abroad are advised to apply for ISEEU/ISPEU Parificato universitario certification at the approved CAF, CIA (located in Padua in Via Longhin, 25), by 31-07-22 in order to obtain the ISEEU/ISPEU within the term for submitting the online application.

Only as an exception, international students enrolled on the first year of a course will be able to supplement their application for participation in the Competition by submitting their "ISEE parificato universitario" by 30-11-2022 (please refer to annex 4, an integral and essential part of this Notice).

N.B.:

For ISEE purposes, students who were beneficiaries of a scholarship received in the year 2020 will have to notify this fact in order to ascertain eligibility for the scholarship. This amount will be separated for the purpose of calculating the ISEE for DSU.

Only students who have transferred from another institution, not part of ESU Padua, or students enrolled for the 1st year at Conservatoires, if they graduated elsewhere, must produce appropriate documentation, indicating the amount of any scholarship received in the year 2020 at the original institution.

1.3.2 - Merit requirements

1.3.2.1 - Students first years

For students enrolled on the first year of three-year courses in the A.Y. 2022/2023 the right to be included in the eligibility rankings is determined only by the requirement relating to their financial position. The merit requirement is assessed ex-post, taking into account the credits accrued during the reference academic year.

The disbursement of the scholarship is divided into 2 instalments, of which the second is subject to the achievement, **by 10.08.2023, of at least 20 credits (10 credits if enrolled on part-time study regime)**, without recognition of merits obtained in previous careers.

This provision does not apply to students with disabilities between 66% and 100% and/or with recognition of disabilities pursuant to Article 3, paragraph 1 of Law no. 104/19

N.B.

Students enrolled in the first year of specialisation degree course (magistrale) or second level diploma (two-year) must also possess the merit requirements corresponding to at least 150 credits in order to be eligible for the assignment of an ESU university accommodation.

*In all cases, if the above students do not obtain 20 credits by **30 November 2023**, they will have to return the full amount of the scholarship and pay the amount equivalent to the value of the service actually enjoyed at eligible rate.*

1.3.2.2 - Students subsequent years

In order to determine the right to be included in the eligibility rankings, the merit requirements are defined as follows:



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- for students of Higher Courses at Conservatoires:
 - students must have obtained a pass mark of not less than 8/10.
- For students of three-year Degree Courses (level I) at the Conservatoires, Degree Courses at the Schools for Linguistic Mediators or CIELS, as at **10.08.2022**:

For students of Level II Courses (bienni) at the Conservatoires, as at **10.08.2022**:

Second year	30 credits	15 credits
Third year	80 credits	30 credits
Fourth year (P.T. only)	---	60 credits
Fifth year (P.T. only)	---	80 credits

Credits are valid only if recognised for the course of study for which students request the benefit, even if different from that of the previous year.

Validated credits from training activities carried out outside the Institution (professional training courses, seminars, traineeships, etc.) and validated credits from previous concluded study courses (e.g. Single Courses), do not contribute to the determination of the merit considered for purposes of eligibility for housing or scholarships.

Merit requirements for access to the benefits for students enrolled on the second year also provide for the fulfilment of any Additional Learning Requirements (**OFA**), where required at the time of admission to the courses.

Eligibility for the accommodation competition is, therefore, also subject to passing of these OFA within the deadlines established by the system of the applicant's Institution.

N.B.: In the event of matriculation with shortening of period of study (which must be promptly notified by email to dirittoallostudio@esu.pd.it), students enrolled in the years subsequent to the first of a three-year degree (laurea triennale), specialisation/on a two-year course (magistrale/biennio), are still required to achieve at least 55 CFU (university training credits) in the period from 10/08/2021 to 10/08/2022.

It will therefore be the student's responsibility to **ensure that all credits obtained by 10 August 2022 have been recorded** by the relevant school secretariats.

Any **checks on credits** obtained must be carried out by applicants by contacting the **Secretariat** of their respective Conservatoire or School and the relevant data must be aligned **by 21.10.2022**.

For **students with disabilities**, special criteria are provided for determining their merit and income (see point 5 – *Students with disabilities*)



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1.3.3 – Bonus Credits

In order to achieve the merit requirements, students enrolled can use a **bonus** in addition to the credits actually obtained.

This bonus can be used only once within the entire course of study and is of different value depending on when it is applied, as indicated below.

Enrolment year	Bonus
Second year	5 bonus credits
Third year	12 bonus credits
Last semester/specialisation	15 bonus credits

If the bonus is not used in full, the surplus can be used in subsequent years. The bonus portion not used during a three-year degree course can also be used in one of the years of attendance. If the bonus is not used in full, the surplus can be used in subsequent years. The bonus portion not used during a three-year degree course can also be used in one of the years of attendance on the master's degree.

The application of the bonus is automatically granted for students who, in the absence of CFU (university training credits), can reach the threshold of merit required for obtaining eligibility for the benefit.

Students enrolled on years subsequent to the first of the specialisation degree course (laurea magistrale) who have obtained a three-year degree (laurea triennale) from another University, must notify the bonus used during the course of the Degree as well as the previous University, by sending an email to dirittoallostudio@esu.pd.it after completing the form for participation in the accommodation competition.

There is no bonus for the achievement of the merit requirements by **part-time students**.

This provision **does not apply to students enrolled on the second level degree courses** (bienni) **deriving from old systems (higher courses/corsi superiori)**.

Application is made automatically by the Office (without prior request from the student) for those who, in the absence of CFU (university training credits), can reach the threshold of merit required for obtaining eligibility for the benefit.

Students enrolled on years subsequent to the first of the two-year specialisation course (Biennio/L Magistrale) who have obtained a three-year degree (laurea triennale) from another University/School/Conservatoire **must notify** the bonus used during the course of the three-year degree (Triennale) as well as the previous Institution, by sending an email to dirittoallostudio@esu.pd.it after completing the form for participation in the accommodation and scholarship competition.

1.3.4 – SCHOLARSHIP FUNDING

The funds for the provision of regional scholarships for the A.Y. 2022/2023 derive from:

- from the proceeds of the Regional Tax (TR) for the Right to University Study (DSU);
- portion of the State Supplementary Fund specifically established pursuant to Legislative Decree No. 68/2012 and the DPCM of 9 April 2001;
- Veneto Region resources pursuant to Legislative Decree No. 68/2012.
- European Union funding - Next Generation EU

The resources deriving from DSU Regional Tax revenue, from the Supplementary Fund and from the additional regional resources, are distributed using the following criteria:



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- a. **30% to students enrolled for the first time on the first year of the three-year and two-year degree courses (laurea triennale and magistrale/bienni)**, of which only 5% as the maximum limit, reserved for non-EU students enrolled for the first time on the first year of the three-year degree courses;
- b. **70% to students enrolled on years after the first of all courses**

1.3.5 – AMOUNT OF SCHOLARSHIPS AND PAYMENT METHODS

The scholarship amount is equal to:

Student status	Maximum amount	Minimum amount
Off-Site Students	€ 6,157.74	€ 3,078.87
Commuter Students	€ 3,598.51	€ 1,799.26
On-Site Students	€ 2,481.75 + a free daily meal	€ 1,240.88

For students enrolled on **part-time** study, the amount of the scholarship is paid entirely and is equal to:

Student status	Maximum amount	Minimum amount
Off-Site Students	€ 3,078.87	€ 1,539.43
Commuter Students	€ 1,799.26	€ 899.63
ON-SITE STUDENTS	€ 1,240.88	€ 620.44

The scholarship is paid in full to students with ISEE less than or equal to **Euros 16,223.40**.

In order to facilitate the most financially disadvantaged, for students with ISEE equal to or less than **Euro 12,167.54**, the amount of the scholarship due is **increased by 15%**.

For ISEE between Euros 16,223.40 and Euros 24,335.56, the scholarship is reduced proportionally up to the minimum amount indicated in the table.

The amount of the scholarship is increased by 20% for students enrolled on several courses of study at the same time. Students must possess and maintain the merit requirements provided for the course for which they have applied for the benefit.

The increases of 15% and 20% are not cumulative.

The first assignment of the scholarships will be paid:

- in one single instalment by 31.12.2022 for those enrolled on the higher courses at Conservatoires, on subsequent years of the I and II level courses at Conservatoires and on subsequent years of three-year degree (Laurea Triennale) or two-year specialisation (Magistrale) courses at Schools for Language Mediators and CIELS;
- in two instalments for those enrolled on the first year of the first and second level courses at Conservatoires and three-year (Triennale) and specialisation (Magistrale) courses at Schools for Language Mediators and CIELS:
 - 1st instalment, 50% of the scholarship, by 31.12.2022
 - 2nd instalment, 50% of the scholarship after verifying that the 20 credits required by 10.08.2023 have been achieved.

Appropriate notification will be sent to each beneficiary student regarding the times and methods for collecting the amounts due.



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Scholarship disbursements subsequent to the first assignment depend on the timing of liquidation of the additional resources provided by the Veneto Region and MIUR.

Those who participate in **international mobility programmes** in any case keep the regional scholarship originally due to them (off-site/commuter/on-site scholarship) without the possibility of increasing the aforementioned scholarship.

In the event that part of the scholarship is provided in services, the amounts thereof are determined as follows:

Type of deduction	Amount in Euro
Accommodation only (if ESU)	€ 1,600.00
Food only (one daily meal)	
Off-Site Student	€ 700.00
Commuter Student	€ 500.00
Food (one daily meal) + accommodation	€ 2,300.00

These amounts will be withheld in full from the amount of the first instalment of the scholarship due.

Students who achieve their degree within the duration foreseen by their didactic system will obtain a supplement to the scholarship equal to half of that obtained in the last year of the course, available resources permitting after the payment to all eligible candidates for scholarships registered for the academic year of reference.

The amount of the scholarship and the deductions for **students enrolled** on the last semester of the degree courses will be attributed to the extent of 50% of their value.

As regards the part of the **scholarship provided in services, it is not possible to request payment in cash even in the event of the non-use of the service itself**

1.3.6 – REVOCATION OF SCHOLARSHIP

Those who incur the loss of eligibility for the scholarship with consequent revocation and return of the sums received and the obligation to pay for DSU services used (full amount of the scholarship, the amount of Regional Tax for DSU reimbursed, the amount for accommodation services (at eligible accommodation rate) and catering (with tariff b) effectively received are as follows:

- **Scholarship recipients enrolled on the first year** (three-year and master's courses) at the Higher School and three-year and two-year courses at the Conservatories for the A.Y. 2022/2023, who gain **20 credits** by **30.11.2023** (**10 credits** if enrolled for part-time study) valid for the enrolment course of study will keep **only** first instalment of the scholarship. If the aforementioned merit requirements are not met **at all by 30.11.2023** the scholarship **will be definitively revoked** with consequent **obligation to return the amounts indicated above**.
- **Scholarship recipients enrolled on subsequent years** will not incur revocation of the scholarship received for reasons of merit).
In exceptional and explained circumstances, made known to the Veneto Region, ESU may defer the deadline for achieving the minimum levels of merit required to avoid revocation by no more than 3 months.
- **All students receiving a scholarship** who have submitted an application to withdraw from their studies, or to transfer to another Conservatoire/Higher School/University not part of this Company, during the 2022/2023 academic year or in any case by 30 September 2022, regardless of the number of credits achieved will incur in the revocation of their scholarship.
- Those who withdraw from their studies and intend to compete again for the scholarship in a possible future career of the same level as the that withdrawn from, must send an application renouncing the benefit and return of the scholarship received (fees for services and Regional Tax included) via email to dirittoallostudio@esu.pd.it
- Students with unpaid debt towards the Company.



- Students who make, or who in previous years have made, false statements. These students will remain excluded from the granting of benefits throughout their courses of study.

1.4 - ACCOMMODATION PLACES COMPETITION AND RESERVES

For the academic year 2022/2023, ESU has accommodation available through competition of 18 beds, without prejudice to unforeseeable situations, in the housing listed in annex 1, an integral and essential part of this Notice.

When completing the application, residences should be indicated in progressive order of **preference**; however **the allocation of accommodation is not bound by the preference expressed.**

It is not possible to express a preference for a single or double room.

1.4.1 - ALLOCATION OF ACCOMMODATION RESERVES

The accommodation in the competition is divided into percentages and reserved based on the student's origin and year of enrolment as follows:

1.5 – Accommodation rates applied and payment methods

The rates applied to participants in the competition are identified in Annex 4, an integral and essential part of this Notice, and applied using the following criteria:

Full Rate: to Off-site students who are beneficiaries of a regional scholarship for whom accommodation has been deducted from the regional scholarship. This rate also includes autonomous province, regional,



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public bodies/institution scholarship students and Doctoral students/Postgraduates (not in the medical area).

Reduced rate: for **Off Site** students who, after taking part in the accommodation competition, were **eligible for the regional scholarship, but not beneficiaries due to lack of funds**. The reduced rate will be applied only after the publication of the results of the competition announcement for regional scholarships. Before the publication of these results, students will have to pay the full rate, pending later adjustment.

Eligible Commuter rate: COMMUTER students in possession of the eligibility requirements, subsequently residually and conditionally admitted to the ranking with respect to Off-Site student

Non-Eligible Rate: students admitted to the ranking and assignees, who, for any admissible reason, have subsequently lost the requisites for granting the benefit.

The surcharge as per the table included in Annex 1, an integral and essential part of this Notice, will be added to the Full, Reduced, Commuter and Non-Eligible rates.

Fees include utilities and the use of ancillary services in the residences, for example: Internet connection, air conditioning (where available), concierge service etc.

Any interruption to these services does not entitle you to refunds or price reductions.

N.B.:

From students who are recipients of regional scholarships, **off-site**, and assignees of accommodation, the amount of **Euro 1,600.00** will be withheld (Euro 800 for students enrolled for the last semester) for the payment of fees.

For any scholarship student recipient of accommodation, whose fees due are less than the deduction made, the difference will be refunded to the IBAN indicated on the application or in the dedicated area.

For any scholarship student recipient of accommodation, whose fees due are greater than the deduction made, the student shall make the payment of the difference according to the deadlines and methods specified in the General Regulations of the University Residences.

2 - HOW TO APPLY

2.1 - Online competition application

The application must be completed by accessing ESU Padova online services from the official portal <https://myesupd.dirittoallostudio.it> and involves the following stages:

- 1) **ACCESS:** "ACCESS using MyID, SPID or CIE";

The following categories cannot access using SPID:

- Students under the age of 18
- International adult students who do not have a valid Italian identity document and who do not have an Italian tax code.

The above students must proceed with ACCREDITATION by means of username and password of the person concerned and UPLOAD of a copy in PDF format of a valid passport. This access enables the "Esu Padova - Sportello Studente/ Student Help Desk", where all topics of interest can be accessed.



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- 2) **COMPLETING APPLICATION** from the student help desk in the “ACCOMMODATION AND SCHOLARSHIP REQUEST FOR CONSERVATOIRE/SSML STUDENTS”;

Applicants for ESU Accommodation must indicate their order of **preference, but assignment of accommodation is not bound by the preference expressed.**

Applications for participation in the competition are completed by selecting **CONFIRM** by the closing date and time indicated in the notice.

The ESU online services information system guarantees receipt of the application within the terms of entry, assigning a protocol number that students can download 24 hours after CONFIRMATION from the **RECEIVED APPLICATIONS 2022/2023** from the Sportello Studente/Student Help Desk Home Page.

N.B.: The protocol number of the application will be used in the publication of the scholarship ranking.

- 3) **SUPPLEMENTING APPLICATION:** once CONFIRMED, the application MUST be supplemented, by accessing the areas

- a. **COMPLETION OF INCOME DATA**, in which the financial data taken from the **ISEE 2022 or ISEE Parificato universitario 2022 certification** relating to Right to University Study Subsidies must be entered.
- students residing in Italy must enter the identification data of the ISEE certificate (INPS protocol number and date of issue) and the ISR, ISP and ISE values from the ISEE certificate.
 - Foreign students or Italian students resident abroad must enter the date of issue and the ISEEU and ISPEU values deducible from the ISEE Parificato universitario 2022.

Please ensure that you submit your "DSU" (Single Substitute Declaration) to the "CAF" (Tax Assistance Centre) to calculate your ISEE in order to meet the deadline for submitting your application., bearing in mind that at least 15 working days are necessary for issuing certificates by the CAF, who cannot be held responsible for any delay.

Foreign or Italian students residing abroad must request their "ISEE Parificato universitario" from the CAF with which we have special arrangements CIA, located in Via Longhin, 25, Padua. It is advisable to complete the application for your ISEE/ISPE and Parificato by 31/07/2022 in order to receive your ISEE in time for the first assignment.

The procedure for applications and certificate issue is only accessible on-line.

For details about the procedure, please refer to annex 4, an integral and essential part of this Notice.

N.B.:

- it is the student's responsibility to verify the correctness and completeness of all the data entered.
 - failure to enter, or incorrect indication of, the protocol number of the ISEE Certification on the Form and/or failure to fill in the aforementioned section will result in NON-ELIGIBILITY for the Competition.
- 4) **UPLOAD DOCUMENTS**, INSERTING THE REQUIRED DOCUMENTS (e.g. ISEE parificato certification, lease agreement, receipt of payment of the **Regional Tax for the Right to University Study...**)

Students can personally **edit/complete** her/his application (eg status, personal data, IBAN, income data...) **no later than the submission deadline date.**

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(<https://myesupd.dirittoallostudio.it>), in the manner required by the Notice of Competition – accessing via SPID or using credentials issued by ESU - the application for accommodation is deemed to be signed by the student using electronic signature.

All information relating to the online application is available from the Student Help Desk, accessible via your credentials from the portal <https://myesupd.dirittoallostudio.it>.

Applications submitted after the deadline will not be admitted to the competition.

2.2 - ONLINE APPLICATION PROCESSING

In order to determine eligibility for accommodation and scholarship competitions, the information acquired by the computer system will be subject to checks. ESU will carry out checks on databases (Agenzia delle Entrate, INPS, SIATEL...) and will electronically acquire the merit status of students from the competent enrolment institutions. **It will therefore be the student's responsibility to ensure that all credits obtained by 10 August 2022 have been recorded.**

For **students with disabilities** special criteria are provided for determining their merit and and income (annex 4, an integral and essential part of this Notice).

2.3 - Online application processing

There are **five different rankings**:

- for students with EU citizenship enrolled in the first year of all courses and for non-EU students enrolled in the first year of two years (biennio);
- for students with non-EU citizenship enrolled in the first year of three-year degree (laurea triennale) courses;
- for students enrolled at Conservatoires, in the second and subsequent years of all degree courses;
- for students enrolled at SSML, in the second and subsequent years of all degree courses;
- for students enrolled on higher courses (Corsi Superiori) at Conservatoires.

The rankings of potential beneficiaries are formulated as follows:

- students enrolled on higher courses (Corsi Superiori) at Conservatoires, based on the overall merit achieved (which must not be less than 8 tenths).
On equal merit, the position will be determined in ascending order based on the Indicator of Equivalent Economic Situation (ISEE) for DSU subsidies.
- For students enrolled in the first year of level I or II courses at Conservatoires, three-year courses at the Schools for Linguistic Mediators or CIELS, as well as the second cycle two-year courses at CIELS Padua, on the basis of rising Indicator of Equivalent Economic Situation (ISEE)
- For those enrolled on years subsequent to the first of the Courses at Conservatoires, Schools for Linguistic Mediators or CIELS, based on the merit achieved:

In the event of a tie, the financial values (ISEE) will be considered in ascending order to determine the position in the ranking.

- **Non-EU International students enrolled on the first year**, on the basis of:
 - increasing ISEE Parificato Universitario;
 - Increasing chronological age with the same ISEE Parificato universitario.



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2.4 – PUBLICATION OF THE RANKINGS

PUBLICATION OF THOSE ELIGIBLE FOR ACCOMMODATION

The ranking will be accessible from the portal <https://myesupd.dirittoallostudio.it> > > **Servizi Online/Online Services**, which can be accessed using your credentials (username and password), in the Sportello Studente/Student Help Desk:

- **provisional rankings** by **18 October 2022**: those involved will be able to assess their eligibility/status and report any errors using the RICORSI/APPEALS area by **26 October 2022**.
- **final rankings** of those eligible to obtain the regional scholarship by **8 November 2022**. The final rankings will also be published on the official website in anonymous form (application protocol number).
- Eligibility for the scholarship does not guarantee the disbursement of the benefit, which depends on the economic resources available. The position in the final ranking determines the priority of the assignment of the scholarship.

PUBLICATION OF ACCOMMODATION ASSIGNEES

The positions in the ranking of the students eligible for the competition and those assigned accommodation will be visible from **19 September 2022** in the personal area <https://myesupd.dirittoallostudio.it> > **Servizi Online/Online Services**, which can be consulted using credentials (SPID or username and password) in the Sportello Studente/Student Help Desk.

The positions in the ranking will be updated periodically as accommodation is assigned.

Accommodation places will be assigned to students already enrolled/matriculated for the 2022/2023 A.Y. (**pre-enrolled students** must prove full enrolment **by 31/10/2022**).

2.5 - ACCOMMODATION ASSIGNMENT AND ACCEPTANCE

To Off-site and Commuter students enrolled on the Courses at the Conservatoires of Adria, Castelfranco Veneto, Padua, Rovigo and Vicenza, at the Schools for Linguistic Mediators of Padua and Vicenza (including the Belluno site) and the School for Linguistic Mediators - CIELS Padua **18** accommodation places are reserved in the ESU residences listed in Point 10

The benefit is granted primarily to Off-Site students with merit and income eligibility requirements.

2.5.1 - SENDING OF OFFERS

Allocation of accommodation to students eligible for the competition will be made on **19.09.2022**. Confirmation of the assigned place is subject to payment of the deposit (**Euro 350.00**) by **21.09.2022**.

Any subsequent assignments will be made using the places made available after the previous assignment.

Should the need arise, the assignment date indicated may be subject to change. Any changes will be notified on the official website.

Once the **payment deadline has expired** without the student paying the deposit, the student will **forfeit the assignment** and the accommodation place will be used for subsequent assignments.

The deposit will be transformed into a **security deposit** once the accommodation is taken.

For details on the regulations regarding the deposit, please refer to Annex 1, an integral and essential part of this Notice.

Students who have taken possession of the accommodation are required to comply with the General Regulations of the University Residences, published on the official website.



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2.5.2 – ACCESS TO THE RESIDENCE

Students who are eligible for the competition - and who are duly enrolled at the University of Padua for the A.Y. 2022/2023 (enrolling students **must prove full enrolment by 31/01/2023**) - must access residences from **26.09.2022**

Before entering the residence, assignees are required to participate in a presentation and information meeting on residential services, which will be held via a digital platform. The meetings, with maximum duration of 30 minutes, will illustrate the regulations of the Residences and present those in charge. **Participation is compulsory** and notification from the Residence Sector will be sent 48 hours before the event.

Upon entering the residence, the assignee must show his/her identity document.

By signing the room key collection form, the assignee accepts the accommodation and the General Regulations of the University Residences.

Students will be able to access the residences until 10.00 am on 21/07/2023.

Students who do not plan to arrive on **26.09.2022**, are required to notify the date of their arrival by initiating a "Ticket" on the portal <https://myesupd.residenze.it> > Residenza/Residences > Informazioni generali/General information by **26.09.2022**.

2.6 - THOSE NOT ELIGIBLE

Once assignments of the eligible students are depleted, the rankings lapse in all respects.

Any residual accommodation can be assigned to students who submit an application in the appropriate surplus **accommodation application Form (area “Domanda posto letto extra concorso”)** from the Sportello studente/Student Help Desk according to the methods that will be published on the website after 31 October 2022. If assigned, these students will be charged the relative **“Non Eligible” rate**.

3 - OTHER INFORMATION

3.1 - Assessment of financial position (article 71 of presidential decree no. 445/2000)

For the purpose of ascertaining the Financial Position, ESU Padua carries out checks on the actual condition of the student on a sample basis - even after the assignment of the benefit - and if the non-truthfulness of what has been declared is proven, ESU will immediately revoke the accommodation assigned (or request payment of the monetary value of the benefit enjoyed) and will also apply the legal sanctions envisaged.

To this end, ESU Padua may carry out, with every available means, investigations deemed appropriate and also request information from the Authorities concerned. ESU Padua may carry out checks on databases (SIATEL, INPS) and tax checks. Furthermore, ESU will send data relating to the students benefiting from DSU to those institutions that request it and also the lists of students assigned accommodation with reduced or full fees to INPS and the Provincial Command of the Guardia di Finanza.

Anyone who, without being in the conditions established by the relevant laws, uses the service referred to in this notice as a result of untruthful declarations, made by themselves or their relatives, shall lose the right to obtain any benefits and/or services provided by ESU, for the duration of the course of study, without prejudice to reporting



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any unlawful deed identified to the appropriate authorities (articles 75 and 76 of Presidential Decree No. 445/2000), and shall be fined in the amount of three times the sum due (art 10 D.Lvo 68/2012).

3.2 - Information regarding the use of personal data (gdpr)

Pursuant to Article 13 of European Regulation 2016/679 (GDPR), the data acquired through self-certification as well as data contained in the required documentation is intended for the processing of the rankings of students for the assignment of university accommodation as per L.R. n° 8/1998.

The provision of data is necessary for participation in the competition and failure to provide data will result in exclusion from the competition.

The collected data may be communicated to other public bodies if necessary for the performance of the institutional functions of ESU or by virtue of legal obligations.

The processing of personal data will be based on the principles of fairness, lawfulness and transparency and for the protection of the Data Subject.

The data processing will be carried out in an automated and/or manual form, in compliance with the provisions of art. 32 of the GDPR 2016/679 on security measures, by authorised parties and in compliance with the provisions of art 29 of the GDPR.

The collected data may be used for statistical purposes for the production of studies and research into the right to study or, in any case, for further information relating to the institutional competences of ESU.

Data may also be used to inform students about initiatives and projects carried out by ESU or by persons working with ESU.

The interested parties are recognised the rights provided by the Regulation, in particular access to personal data; rectification / erasure / limitation of processing (Arts.16-17 and 18 of the GDPR); challenge and lodge of complaint (art 77 of the GDPR).

The data will be kept for the period of time necessary to achieve the purposes for which they are collected and processed, in compliance with the principles of lawfulness and minimisation, and in any case for a period not exceeding 10 years. The data will not be transferred outside the territory of the European Union.

Confirmation of the assigned place is subject to payment of the deposit by the deadlines shown in point 2.5. The amount of the deposit is set at **€ 350.00**.

The deposit will be transformed into a **security deposit** once you have taken the accommodation.

RELINQUISHMENT OF ACCOMMODATION AND REFUND OF THE DEPOSIT/SECURITY DEPOSIT

Refunding the deposit, in the event of relinquishing accommodation, is regulated as follows:

- 1) Relinquishment by 31-10-2022:
 - a) If the accommodation is relinquished before 30 September and without the student collecting the room key, the deposit will be refunded in full;
 - b) If the accommodation is relinquished between 1 October and 15 October and without the student collecting the room key, half of the monthly fees will be deducted from the deposit at the "Non-Eligible" rate;
 - c) If the accommodation is relinquished after 15 October and without the student collecting the room key, the deposit will be fully withheld;
 - d) If the student has collected the room key, the security deposit will be fully withheld regardless of the date of notification of relinquishment.
- 2) Relinquishment after 31-10-2022:
 - a) This is permitted only for valid and documented reasons which must be notified by initiating a "Ticket" on the portal <https://myesupd.residenze.it> > Residenze/Residences at least 30 days before departure and in any case no later than 28 February. (for details see Article 7 of the General Regulations of the University Residences).



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Method of payment of the deposit and fees

Payment of the deposit can be made through the PagoPa-MyPay, by connecting to <https://myesupd.dirittoallostudio.it>, as described in the General Regulations of the University Residences.

Accommodation fees must be paid in the same way, according to the deadlines indicated in the General Regulations for University Residences.

Different payment methods (for example bank transfer) will be allowed only in exceptional circumstances and only upon reasoned request made via "ticket" to the web site <https://myesupd.residenze.it> > Residence/residenza > Informazioni generali/General Informations.

For further details, please refer to the General Regulations for University Residences A.Y. 2022/2023.



ANNEX 2 – STUDENTS WITH DISABILITIES

Special terms and conditions apply to students with disabilities, with recognition pursuant to Article 3, paragraph 1, of L 05/05/1992, no. 104 or with a disability recognised, and duly documented, by the National Health Service at $\geq 66\%$:

- In consideration of the number of years for which they can compete to obtain the benefit. Students with disabilities between 66% and 100% can compete for a different number of years/semesters, starting from the year of enrolment according to the following table:

Three-Year/Triennale	5 years
Specialisation (Magistrale)	4 years
Single cycle master's/(Magistrale ciclo unico)	Equal to n years equal to legal course duration + 2

- In determining the merit to be acquired by 10 August 2022 according to the following tables:

For the achievement of the merit requirements, students with disabilities can use, in addition to credits actually achieved, a Bonus accrued based on the year of the course attended. This bonus can be used only once within the entire course of study and is of different value depending on when it is applied, according to the following table:

Enrolment year	Disability between 66% and 80%	Disability between 81% and 100%
second year	4 credits bonus	3 credits bonus
third year	9 credits bonus	7 credits bonus
fourth year	12 credits bonus	9 credits bonus

If the **bonus** is not used in full, the surplus can be used in subsequent years.

The bonus portion not used during a three-year degree course can also be used in one of the years of attendance on the master's degree/laurea magistrale..

The application of the bonus is automatically granted for students who, in the absence of CFU (university training credits), can reach the threshold of merit required for obtaining eligibility for the benefit.

Students enrolled on years subsequent to the first of the specialisation degree course (laurea magistrale) who have obtained a three-year degree (laurea triennale) from another University, **must notify** the bonus used during the course of the Degree as well as the previous University, by sending an email to dirittoallostudio@esu.pd.it after completing the form for participation in the accommodation competition.

Request for helper/carers

Students with disabilities who need one or two carers in their accommodation, must indicate this in the online application and notify the names of their carers to the ESU Settore Residenze/Residence Sector by initiating a "Ticket" at the Sportello Studente/Student Help Desk <https://myesupd.residenze.it> > Residenze/Residences > Informazioni generali/General information.

Please note that administration of the "notified" helper/carers (from the administrative handling of the request to the provision of accommodation) takes at least 3 working days.

For students without helper/carers, ESU will make available to those concerned the list of students who have indicated their willingness to be helpers in their online application.

Only students with ascertained motor disabilities can have 2 helper/carers.

All students with disabilities must contact the Residence Sector as soon as possible about special needs related to community life by **6 September 2022**.

The Right to Study Sector may request documentation certifying the state of disability and carry out checks.

Students with disabilities who are eligible for the ESU Accommodation Competition are not required to pay any fees for the hospitality of any helper.

Students with disabilities not eligible for the competition

Notwithstanding the provisions for the allocation of places, ESU may admit students with disabilities who are **not suitable for the competition** within the limit of the equipped places available, applying the "Non Eligible-ineligible to compete" rate.



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The rate for the helper/carer's accommodation will be the same as that attributed to the disabled student who is not eligible for the competition.

ESU will grant disabled students who are not eligible for the competition a contribution based on their ISEE indicator for each helper/carer, according to the following table:

Helper/carers will benefit from free catering for the entire period of their assistance.

Student with disabilities must notify the names of their helpers/carers and any changes **promptly** to the Residence Sector by initiating a "Ticket" via the portal <https://myesupd.residenze.it> > Residenze/Residences > Informazioni generali/General information..



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ANNEX 3 – ISEE

The ISEE (Indicator of the Equivalent Economic Situation) is the indicator that summarises the financial and asset status, taking into account the income, assets and number of members of the family unit.

To obtain the ISEE certificate for Right to University Study Subsidies, it is necessary to consult a CAF/qualified professional or the INPS website, after completing the **Dichiarazione Sostitutiva Unica/Single Substitute Declaration (DSU)** made by the student to the CAF, or INPS (by connecting to the website <https://servizi2.inps.it/servizi/Iseeriforma/home.aspx>) for the determination of the financial status of the family unit of the applicant for the subsidies, pursuant to DPCM 5/12/2013 no. 159, as amended and supplemented

Once the DSU has been submitted, the declarant is issued with an acknowledgement of submission but not the ISEE calculation. In order to calculate the ISEE, other data will need to be acquired by INPS and the Revenue Agency

PRE-COMPLETED ISEE

Using the **online pre-completed ISEE service** it is possible to send the **Dichiarazione Sostitutiva Unica (DSU Single Substitute Declaration)** to INPS and obtain a **pre-completed ISEE** certificate, thus avoiding going to the CAF

N.B.

ISEE Certificate for right to university study subsidies is issued approximately 15 working days from submission of the DSU. It is the responsibility of the applicant to obtain the ISEE and necessary information/documents in good time to meet the deadlines set for participation in the Accommodation Competition

ISEE REQUIREMENTS

- The ISEE to be requested is that for Right to University Study Subsidies, valid on the date of application and confirmation of the application;
- Any omissions and/or discrepancies in the ISEE certificate must be remedied by requesting and obtaining a new certificate in compliance with the application deadline dates.
- The ISEE, issued during a given calendar year, is valid until 31 December of the same year and refers to the income and assets of the student's family unit two years before.
Example: the ISEE certificate issued during 2022 expires on 31 December 2022, and refers to income and assets of the calendar year 2020.
- **FAMILY UNIT:** The family unit generally coincides with that recorded at the registry office, resulting from the family status at the date of signing the DSU and the income and assets of the family unit are that resulting from the sum of the income and assets received by the each family member.



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- Even if the student resides alone, he must still aggregate the income and assets of his parents unless s/he constitutes a single unit.
- SINGLE UNIT if the student resides alone and both the requisites required by art. 8 of DPCM 159/2013 are met:
 - a) Residence outside the home of the family of origin for at least two years on the date of signing the DSU, in accommodation not owned by any family member;
 - b) Income from employment or similar assimilated for tax purposes of not less than 9,000.00 EUR per annum.
- Anyone who is orphan of both parents and who officially registered as residing together as a member of a religious order, military unit, host community or body subject to a detention regime, is deemed to be part of a single unit.

ISEE "ORDINARIO"

Those who must apply for the ISEE ORDINARIO:

- Italian students (all genders)/residents in Italy;
- International students (all genders) residing in Italy and with earned income exceeding 9,000.00 Euros.

ISEE "PARIFICATO"

Those who must apply for the ISEE "PARIFICATO" by consulting the affiliated CAF:

- International students (all genders) residing abroad and with family unit residing abroad;
- International students (all genders) residing in Italy with earned income not exceeding 9,000.00 Euros and with family unit residing abroad;
- Italian students (all genders)/residents abroad, whether registered or not in the Register of Italians Residing Abroad (AIRE).

ISEE "CORRENTE"

This indicator is calculated starting from the ISEE "ordinario" for the right to university study with the above requirements. Students whose family unit has had a change in employment situation or a variation, greater than 25%, in income situation indicator may request it. The validity of the ISEE "corrente" is **six months**, starting from the date of submission of the DSU.

The request for the ISEE CORRENTE presupposes the possession of a valid ISEE ORDINARIO.

N.B.: "ISEE CORRENTE" is not the same as "ISEE ORDINARIO"

WHO TO CONTACT

To obtain the ISEE certificate for Right to University Study Subsidies, it is necessary to consult a CAF/qualified professional or the INPS website or the **CAF affiliated with ESU and the University of Padua**.

In this case, students can obtain the ISEE calculation and certification delivery free of charge.

N.B.

ISEE certification must be uploaded to the Carica Documenti/Upload Documents section of the Sportello Studente/Student Help Desk.

In no case will it be possible to accept ISEEs uploaded after the deadline for applications expires.

Documentation to be presented

The documents to be submitted to the CAF for the calculation of the ISEE are as follows:

- Valid personal identity document;
- Tax code issued by the Italian Revenue Agency;
- Any certificate of the student's disability recognised over 66% (medium, severe, non self-sufficient disability).
- enrolment number at Institution (if already enrolled) and degree course.
- For foreign students residing in Italy, DSU and ISEE certification
- The amount of any scholarship received in 2020 only if received outside Unipd; any certificates attesting to the death of one or both parents, any divorce certificate;
- Family status/composition of the student's family unit on the date of submission of the DSU (relating to the year 2022) indicating surname, first name, date of birth and family relationship of all persons belonging to the family unit.
- Income received by each member of the family unit, referring to the year 2020;
- Any other sums received from public administrations by way of welfare, social security and indemnity payments;
- The sums received or paid as support for children in the event of legal separation or divorce.
- Property assets relating to buildings owned in Italy and/or abroad (lack of assets must be expressly specified in the documentation).
- If the family unit resides in rented accommodation, documented value of the annual rent provided for in the rental contract.
- Movable assets, constituting the balance as of 12/31/2020 and average balance for the year 2020, of current accounts, deposits, bank and/post office passbooks held abroad and in Italy and balance as of 12/31/2020 for any other type of investment (securities, shares, life insurance, etc.).

N.B.

For foreign students the above documents must be authenticated.



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ANNEX 4 – INTERNATIONAL AND ITALIAN STUDENTS RESIDING ABROAD

Students who are in the following situations:

- Foreign students with family unit not residing in Italy;
- Foreign students residing in Italy (but with income from employment of less than EURO 9,000.00) and with family residing abroad;
- Italian students residing abroad, whether or not enrolled in the Italian registry of residents abroad (AIRE)

For the purposes of certifying the income requirement, students must apply for the **ISEE PARIFICATO UNIVERSITARIO** from the CAF affiliated with ESU and the University of Padua; this is only accessible on-line.

Students must complete and sign a specific authorisation, available from the University website www.unipd.it/isee; e-mail addresses should be indicated in a clear and legible manner to facilitate communications and the transmission of the ISEE, which is only available online.

Access to the office, under exceptional circumstances, must be authorised in advance by the CAF.

Students, with the complete documentation including the authorisation, must first upload the documents on the CAF CIA portal.

To access the portal, students must request credentials by communicating their tax code and telephone number by e-mail to caf-iseeunipd@ciapadova.it.

Exceptionally, international students enrolling on their first year of studies can supplement their application for participation in the competition for the assignment of accommodation with the presentation of the ISEE/ISEE Parificato Universitario by 30/11/2022. These applications will be evaluated - subsequently - according to the criteria already established for first year students and the allocation of accommodation will take place on the basis of any remaining availability of accommodation

N.B.

ISEE Certification for right to university study subsidies is issued approximately 15 working days from submission of the DSU. It is the responsibility of the applicant to obtain the ISEE and necessary information/documents in good time to meet the deadlines set for participation in the Accommodation Competition.

DOCUMENTATION REQUIRED FOR CALCULATING THE ISEE PARIFICATO UNIVERSITARIO

Pursuant to Article 8, paragraph 3, of Legislative Decree No. 68 of 29/03/2012, the financial position of foreign students or Italian students residing abroad is defined through the Indicator of Equivalent Economic Situation abroad, calculated as the sum of the income received abroad and 20% of the assets owned abroad, valued in the same way and on the basis of the average exchange rate of the Euro in the reference year, defined by decree of the Ministry of Finance pursuant to article 4, paragraph 6, of the Legislative Decree No. 168 of 28/06/1990, transformed, with amendment, by Law No. 227 of 04/08/1990.



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- In addition to the documentation relating to any income and assets produced and held in Italy, the following documents are required
- certification that defines the composition of the family unit with the personal data of each member (in the event of divorce or death, a copy of the decree absolute or death certificate must be available);
- Certification of the total income received in 2020 by all members of the family unit over 18 or certification of unemployment;
- Certification of movable and immovable assets owned at 31.12.2020 by all the members of the family unit, especially in the case of ownership of houses and the measurements of the same;
- any rent agreement for property used as the main residence of the family unit, valid at the date of application for the ISEE.

The tables for the average exchange rate for the Euro are available at: <http://www.unipd.it/borse-studio-alloggi>.

All documents must be issued by the competent authorities of the country where the incomes were produced and the assets owned and must be translated into Italian by the Italian diplomatic authorities competent for the territory (Embassies or Consulates), in the country of origin.

Students from countries where difficulties exist for the issue of documents by the Italian Embassy or Consulate abroad can request them from foreign diplomatic or consular representations in Italy and have documents legalised by the Prefecture.

SPECIAL CASES

- 1) Students from countries with low Human Development Index (a list of these countries is published on the on the Padova University website <https://www.unipd.it/borse-studio-alloggi>) can also present certification attesting that they do not belong to a family known to be of high income and high social level.

Certification must be requested:

- From the Italian Diplomatic Authorities (Embassies or Consulates) in the country of origin.
 - From the home country university for students enrolled at a university with agreements or conventions with the University of Padua.
 - For students who enrol on the first year of degree courses only, certification from Italian bodies authorised to issue financial guarantees; in this case the body issuing the certification undertakes to return the scholarship on behalf of the student in the event of revocation. Students must declare any income and assets held in Italy by their family unit.
- 2) For students recognised as POLITICAL REFUGEES OR STATELESS PERSONS, only income and assets held in Italy are considered.

N.B.

For the purposes of checks, ESU may ask the student to provide the documentation presented to the CAF.

OTHER DOCUMENTS

Students with political refugee status or complementary (subsidiary protection ...) or stateless person status must upload in the appropriate area of the Sportello Studente/Student Help Desk "LOAD DOCUMENTS/CARICA DOCUMENTI":

- pdf of certification of status (Dir 2004/83 EC of 29/4/04 - Legislative Decree 251/2007).



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- pdf of Valid "Permesso di Soggiorno".

For the purposes of access to the benefits

- foreign students with residence permit for study purposes are deemed Off-Site students, regardless of the location of their residence in Italy;
- foreign students with a family unit residing in Italy, to be considered Off-Site students, must meet all the Off-Site requirements set out in article 4, paragraph 8, letter c), of D.P.C.M. of 9/4/2001.

Non-EU foreign students must have a valid residence permit and be enrolled at the University in order to enter accommodation.

The provisions of the T.U. on immigration (Article 4 of Legislative Decree 286/1998), with reference in particular to the minimum means of support provided for by the Directive of 1 March 2000, are deemed fulfilled when in possession of a "permesso di soggiorno" issued by the Questura.

Students who do not submit complete documentation and/or self-certify false information cannot benefit from ESU accommodation at a reduced/full rate and may be subject to the penalties provided for by law.



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ANNEX 5 – EXTRACT FROM THE GENERAL REGULATIONS OF THE UNIVERSITY RESIDENCES

article 1: Assignment of accommodation

When assigned accommodation, students **must be enrolled or enrolling at the University of Padua** and present a valid identity document.

By signing the **Key Collection Form** the student affirms that s/he has read and undertakes to accept the rules set out in these "General Regulations of the University Residences".

Any student participating in the competition who does not accept the accommodation place assigned by ESU according to the terms of the Competition Notice, will renounce the benefit for the academic year to which the competition applies.

Failure to take possession of the **accommodation on the days scheduled for acceptance** must be notified and explained via "Ticket" to "RESIDENZA - Informazioni generali" in <https://myesupd.dirittoallostudio.it> **before the day prior to that of acceptance**. ESU may authorise postponed entry, which is permitted for **up to 15 consecutive days from the date of opening of the residences** or of assignment (if entry is during the year).

After this deadline, failure to enter **will result in the forfeiture of the accommodation benefit and the loss of the security deposit**.

article 2: Access to the accommodation

Upon arrival at the residence, the assignee will receive and sign the delivery report for the key and the room and detailing the condition of the room/apartment and fittings and furnishings. **Within forty-eight hours** of arrival at the residence, the assignee must return the delivery report indicating any discrepancies found.

The Residence Manager will verify the discrepancies found by countersigning the report.

Damage reported beyond the time-limit indicated above will be deemed to have been caused by the assignee.

Failure to sign the delivery report implies automatic confirmation that the accommodation and fittings/furnishings have been consigned in good condition.

With the assignment of accommodation, the conventional furnishings of the room and the bedroom, consisting of blankets, bedspreads and mattress covers, are guaranteed. Linen, such as sheets, pillowcases, towels and pillow, must be provided by the assignee.

article 7: Relinquishment of accommodation and forfeiture for loss of requirements

Relinquishment of accommodation by winners of the competition and by "Other Users": this is permitted only for valid and documented reasons.

Relinquishment must be submitted at least thirty days before departure and in any case no later than 28 February. The release of the accommodation must take place no later than 31 March. The contract will always be ended at the end of the month.

After 28 February, relinquishment is accepted only if the reason is of an academic nature (E.g.: participation in work experience or other equivalent cases at other universities in cities, regions, foreign states, authorised by the University at any time of the A.Y.).



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If relinquishment is not for the valid reasons listed above or is submitted after the deadline, **ESU will retain the security deposit.**

N.B: to receive the scholarship as an Off-Site student, it is necessary to prove that you have an accommodation contract with a duration of at least 10 months (parameter subject to change based on the "Annual Regional Programme for the implementation of the Right to University Study"). **A student who withdraws assumes all the responsibilities deriving from any revocation of the scholarship following withdrawal.**

Forfeiture by virtue of graduation: if an assignee finishes her/his studies before the end of the contract, the accommodation must be vacated at the end of the month in which the degree is obtained and fees paid for the whole month. Graduates may apply to **remain** in their Residence **after their graduation**. In this case, ESU may authorise the use of the accommodation until the deadline set by the notice at the **"Non-Eligible" rate**.

ALL REQUESTS MUST BE SUBMITTED VIA TICKET TO "RESIDENZA - Rinuncia posto letto/Relinquishment accommodation" or "RESIDENZA - Comunicazione avvenuta laurea/Notification of graduation" <https://myesupd.dirittoallostudio.it>.

article 8: Terms of payment

The assignee undertakes to pay accommodation fees for the entire period, according to the status and rates defined by the notice of competition, using the PAGO PA procedure via <https://myesupd.dirittoallostudio.it>.

In exceptional cases when technical difficulties prevent the use of the PAGOPA portal, reported via "Ticket" to "RESIDENZA – Informazioni generali" at <https://myesupd.dirittoallostudio.it> accommodation fees can be paid using the alternative methods indicated.

The payment deadlines are as follows:

- **Off-site students eligible for the competition: payment in three instalments**
 - First instalment: by 31 December for an amount equal to 35% of the annual fee;
 - Second instalment: by 28 February for an amount equal to 35% of the annual fee;
 - Third instalment: by 30 April for an amount equal to 3% of the annual fee;
- **Eligible commuter students, eligible doctoral students and all other users: monthly payment in advance.**

Off-Site students in receipt of a scholarship will be required to pay the University the amount corresponding to the monetary value of the service, the amount of which is defined by the Veneto Regional Council with the approval of the Programme for the implementation of the Right to University Study (DSU) for the academic year 2022/2023 (reduced by 50% for students enrolled in the last semester) for the payment of fees, therefore ESU will require payment only of the part of the fees in excess of the deduction.

For each delayed payment, a fine of € 25.00 will be applied. If delay in payment continues beyond 30 days, a fine of € 50.00 will be applied as per art. 18.

Rates are monthly and cannot be split; if the assignee - not a competition winner - acquires available accommodation after the 16th day of the month, the rate for the first month will be halved. No reduction will be made if the accommodation is made available during or before the 16th day and if the assignee vacates the accommodation before the end of the month.

Requests for instalment payment are taken into consideration only if sent by initiating a "Ticket" via "RESIDENZA – Informazioni generali" at <https://myesupd.dirittoallostudio.it> before the instalment is due, in order to avoid the application of a fine.
