

APPLICATION OF BENEFITS OF THE RIGHT TO EDUCATION FOR STUDENTS ENROLLED IN THE OPEN SEMESTER - ADDITION TO THE COMPETITION FOR THE ALLOCATION OF UNIVERSITY ACCOMMODATION TO STUDENTS ENROLLED AT THE UNIVERSITY OF PADUA FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2025/2026 AND SETTING OF FEES FOR ACCESS TO THE CATERING SERVICE

Approved by Director's Decree no. xxx of xx/xx/2025

As indicated in the Competition Notice in question, approved by Director's Decree 190/2025 and in application of Ministerial Decrees MUR 418/2025, 447/2025 and 454/2025 (and pending any provisions of the Veneto Region as per Article 6 of Ministerial Decree 447/2025) Esu of Padua establishes that students enrolled in the open semester of the courses in Medicine and Surgery, Dentistry and Dental Prosthetics and Veterinary Medicine will be eligible for the benefits of the Right to Education in accordance with the procedures indicated below.

1. APPLICATION OF BENEFITS OF THE RIGHT TO EDUCATION FOR THOSE ENROLLED IN THE OPEN SEMESTER

University accommodation service: Ministerial Decree of the Ministry of University and Research no. 447/2025, art. 2, stipulates that in order to access the benefits of the right to study, the semester must consist of at least 51% of teaching activities in person.

Consequently, accommodation applications already submitted by students enrolled in the open semester at the University of Padua, attending a semester consisting of less than 51% of teaching activities in person, will be automatically excluded.

University catering service: in accordance with Article 6 of Ministerial Decree 447/2025, which provides for the possibility for Regions and bodies managing the right to education to apply more favourable measures, students enrolled in the Open Semester will be able to use the university catering service at the B rate (€4.70/full meal, €3.50/reduced meal).

2. PARTICIPATION IN THE HOUSING COMPETITION FOR THE 2ND SEMESTER

Esu Padova will supplement the application for the Accommodation Competition **from 19 to 27 February 2026**. Only students who have attended the Open Semester in Padua or at another university in Italy and who, by 4 March 2026, are regularly enrolled at the University of Padua in a course in Medicine and Surgery, Dentistry and Dental Prosthetics, Veterinary Medicine or one of the related courses as indicated in Ministerial Decrees 418/2025, Article 8, and 454/2025, Annex 3.

2.1 HOW TO APPLY FOR ACCOMMODATION AND ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

The procedures for submitting online applications will be indicated on the Esu website before the application process begins. The procedures for drawing up the ranking list and for the allocation and acceptance of accommodation will be the same as those indicated in point 2 of the Call for Applications for Accommodation for students enrolled at the University of Padua.

Off-site and commuter students may participate, as indicated in point 1 of the Call for Applications for Accommodation for students enrolled at the University of Padua.

The ranking list will be drawn up on the basis of the financial requirements resulting from **the ISEE/ISEE Equivalent Certificate for the year 2025** requested and issued for 'Subsidised Services for the Right to University Education'.

The maximum income indicators **deriving from the ISEE/ISEE Parificato certificate for the year 2025** and established for the academic year 2025/2026 in order to participate in the Call for Applications are as follows, and both values must be met.

Equivalent Economic Situation Indicator ISEE (for DSU benefits)	26,306.25
Equivalent Net Asset Value Indicator (ISPE) (ISP/equivalence scale)	€42,530.50

If, at the time of housing allocation, the ranking list of students eligible for the 2025/26 Housing Competition is still being processed, students participating in the competition at this stage will be included in the remaining ranking list based on increasing ISEE.

2.2 ALLOCATION OF ACCOMMODATION

Accommodation will be allocated using the places available at that time, **starting on 4 March 2026, with a deadline for acceptance set at 6 March 2026, and will continue every Tuesday of the following weeks with a deadline for acceptance on Friday, until the ranking list or places are exhausted.**

For the purposes of evaluating scholarship applications submitted to the University of Padua, Esu will communicate to the University the names of the students assigned to residences through the Housing Competition, indicating the number of months of assignment.

The rankings and their progress will also be published weekly on the institutional website on the page dedicated to the Housing Competition. All students will be included in the ranking published on the website with their Student Code instead of their first and last names, in order to comply with transparency/privacy requirements. 3.1 INFORMATION ON THE USE OF PERSONAL DATA (GDPR)

Pursuant to Article 13 of European Regulation 2016/679 (GDPR), the data acquired in the self-certification form and those contained in the required documentation will be used to compile a list of students interested in summer accommodation (Regional Law No. 8/1998).

The provision of data is necessary for participation in the selection process and failure to provide such data will result in exclusion from the benefit.

The processing of personal data will be based on principles of correctness, lawfulness, transparency and protection of your rights.

Data processing will be carried out in an automated and/or manual manner, in compliance with the provisions of Article 32 of GDPR 2016/679 on security measures, by authorised persons and in accordance with the provisions of Article 29 of the GDPR.

Data subjects are entitled to the rights provided for in the Regulation, in particular: access to personal data; rectification/erasure/restriction of processing; objection and lodging of a complaint (pursuant to Article 77 of the GDPR) to the Data Protection Authority.

The data will be stored for the period of time necessary to achieve the purposes for which it is collected and processed, in accordance with the principles of lawfulness and minimisation, and in any case for a period not exceeding 10 years.

The data will not be transferred outside the European Union.
